We suggest that the following format be used when referring to pages on this website:

- Author's Last Name, First Name, 'Title of Document.' *Title of Complete Work*. Protocol and address, access path or directories (date of access).
- For example: Baxter, Ron, 'Abingdon Abbey, Berkshire.' *The Corpus of Romanesque Sculpture in Britain and Ireland* <http://www.crsbi.ac.uk/search/county/site/ed-be-abiab.html> (20 June 2005)
